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Driving tests and help with creating an account  
**A SAAQ mobile team will soon be in Blanc-Sablon**

**Saguenay, January 16, 2026.**— The Société de l'assurance automobile du Québec (SAAQ) informs the population of Blanc-Sablon and surrounding areas of the upcoming visit of a mobile team that will allow people wishing to obtain a driver's license or a learner's permit to exchange a driver's license and take the exams.

The mobile team will be on site according to the following schedule, if the demand warrants it :

**Dates:** Tuesday, March 17, 2026, from 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and from 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.  
Wednesday, March 18, 2026, from 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and from 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.  
Thursday, March 19, 2026, from 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and from 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Theory and practical driving tests are offered by appointment only. Call toll-free at 1-800-463-6858 to make an appointment for your driver's license photo, for vehicle registration, for "changing an appointment and for a driving test." You can also make an appointment online by logging into your SAAQ clic account via our website.

You must notify the SAAQ at least 48 hours in advance if you wish to cancel your practical exam appointment, otherwise fees will apply.

**Help creating your SAAQ clic account**

During the mobile team's visit, a staff member will be available to assist you in creating your account with the Government Authentication Service. This account will allow you to access SAAQ clic services. Identity verification will be conducted in the presence of a staff member. You must present two pieces of identification, one of which must be a photo ID, have previously been registered with the Québec health insurance plan, and have your card number ready. The following forms of identification are accepted :

- health insurance card;
- Quebec driver's license;
- Canadian passport (even if expired) or foreign passport;
- permanent residence card;
- citizenship card with photo;
- card of the Canadian Armed Forces;
- birth certificate from Quebec, or an other Canadian province or a Canadian territory;
- certificate of Indian status;

- any letter or official document issued by Immigration Canada proving refugee status.

You will also need to have the following on hand:

- your email address and your password;
- your bank details (they can be found on your checks and in your online banking account).
